Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer operates under the Management of the Mission Sisters of Ajmer, a Sisterhood of Indian Women, whose commitment to God enables them to impart a liberal and enlightened education to young women for the upliftment of humanity.

The college is in its 64<sup>th</sup> year of serving the nation and provides quality higher education to women, as a full-fledged Autonomous 'A+' Grade college affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer. The College offers undergraduate programmes in rts, Science, Commerce, Management, Computer Application, Library Science. It offers Post Graduation in English, Geography, Political Science, Sociology, History, Psychology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Commerce (ABST) and Doctorate in Geography, Chemistry, Computer Science and Commerce.

Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer was established with the vision and mission to uplift and empower the position of women through education. Time and again, it takes the feedback of its stakeholders, namely, the parents, employers, the teaching staff and students and devises various long-term plans along with its effective implementation.

- 4. Established Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with various National and International institutions of Higher Education to facilitate knowledge through exposure and experience.
- 5. Emphasized on Blended Learning, new teaching pedagogies and updating teachers and students regarding the same.
- 6. Ensured effective implementation of LMS- MOODLE

#### **IV. RESEARCH**

The College works towards the development of its faculty by encouraging them to indulge in Academic Research Activities. For this, the College encouraged the staff to enroll and complete their Doctoral Degree, ensured the provision of incentives to the staff members for their research endeavors and gave them the necessary monetary support/Seed money for taking up Institutional Research Projects. #### VII. COMPILATION OF NIRF AND AISHE



- A talk on 'Relevance and Scope of International courses' was conducted on the 29<sup>th</sup> of August, 2022






# KALAM – THE PHYSICS FORUM & RAMANUJAN: THE MATHEMATICS FORUM


