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ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer operates under the Management of the Mission Sisters of Ajmer, a Sisterhood of Indian Women, whose commitment to God enables them to impart a liberal and enlightened education to young women for the upliftment of humanity.

The college is in its 63nd year of serving the nation and provides quality higher education to women, as a full-fledged Autonomous 'A' Grade college affiliated to Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer. The College has the faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Computer Application, Library Science, Honours in English, Political Science, Sociology, Geography, History, Chemistry, Commerce (ABST) and Computer Science. It offers Post Graduation in English, Geography, Political Science, Sociology, History, Chemistry, Computer Science, Commerce (ABST) and Doctorate in Geography, Chemistry, Computer Science and Commerce.

The College had the inspection by University Grants Commission (UGC) on 24th and 25th September 2021. The autonomy is extended for 5 years till 2026. The UGC team gave a very positive feedback of the College.

Sophia Girls' College (Autonomous), Ajmer was established with the vision and mission to uplift and empower the position of women through education. In the academic year 2021-22 there are 1698 students . Time and again, it takes the feedback of its stakeholders, namely, the parents, employers, the teaching staff and students and devises various long term plans along with its effective implementation.
