Step by step as follows —

Point 1 To consider and approve the syllabi of Sem. III and Sem. IV

- The syllabi were read pointwise and discussed among the members. One of the members suggested that in Paper 301, Drink could be removed from point 3 i.e. Food & Dairy products. This was accepted unanimously and the change was done accordingly.
- In Semester paper 302, unit II, Dr. Bhatnagar suggested that Recombinant DNA Technology is a very vast chapter so elementary ideas should be specified to avoid confusion during paper setting.
- Dr. Reena Vyas appreciated the framing of syllabi of 401 and 402 and added that All basic types are included which are relevant from the point of view of competitions.
- In Practical syllabus activity of Salivary amylase digestion could be added in physiology experiment list. This suggestion was welcomed and done.
- Dr. Karuna Shobhawat that Live zoology report should be added in the practicals of 403. This was also accepted by all and implemented.

- Dr Karuna Shobhawat also suggested to add T.B. of Biochemistry by A. K. Berry to the list of books recommended.
- Dr. Maheep Bhatnagar, also suggested to add Elements of Immunology by Fahim Halim Khan published by Pearson.

Point 2 Examination Scheme -

The examination scheme was explained to the board with unitwise pattern and distribution of marks. This was passed unanimously and approved.

Point 3 - Any other -

Dr Maheep Bhatnagar, suggested that since sacrificing animals is not allowed, so a list of specimens and other preserved animals should be made. This list should be reported to the Forest Department so that we are on the safer side in future.
