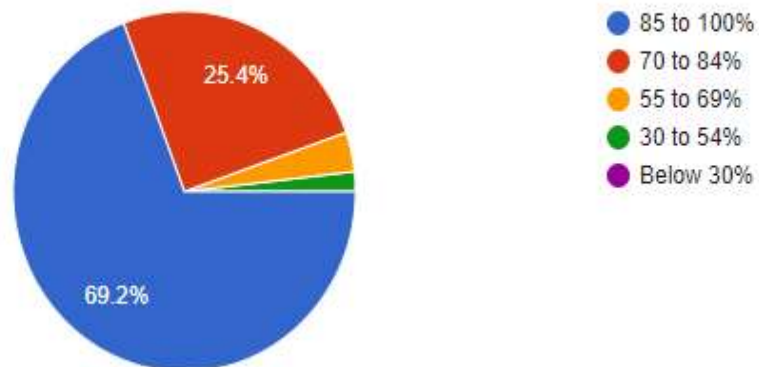

## 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

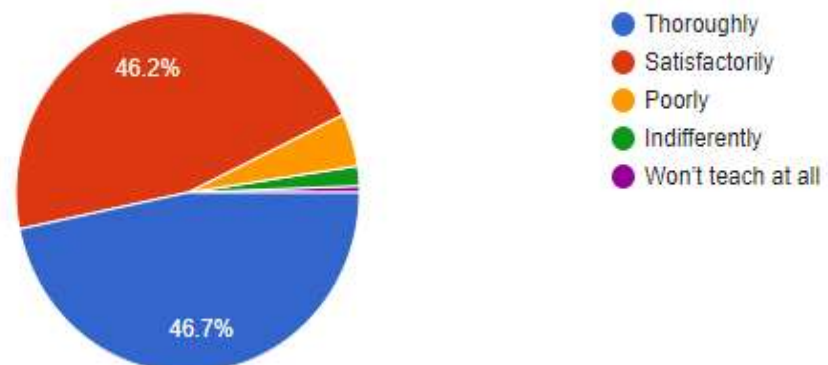
169 responses

## 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

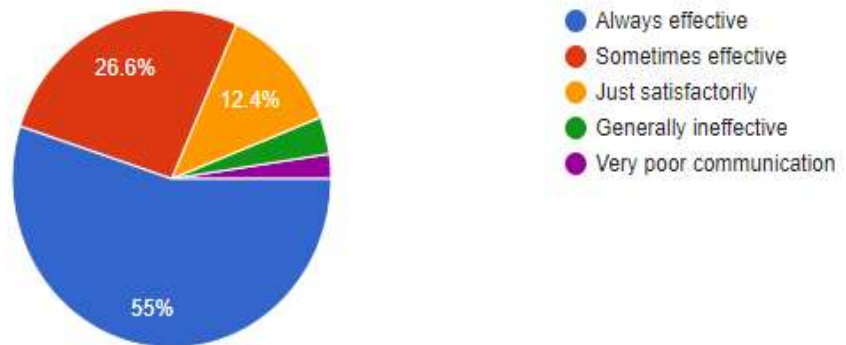
169 responses

## 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

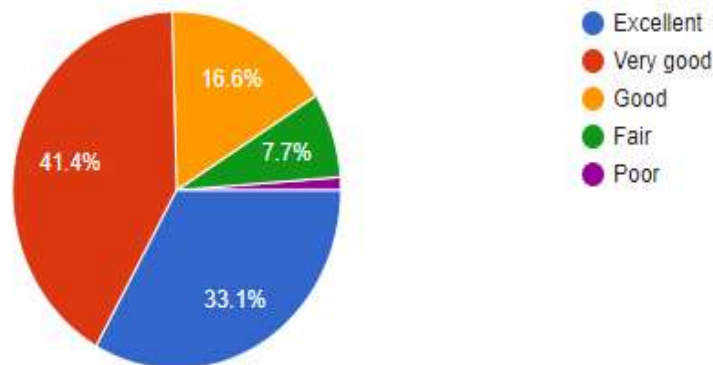

#### 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

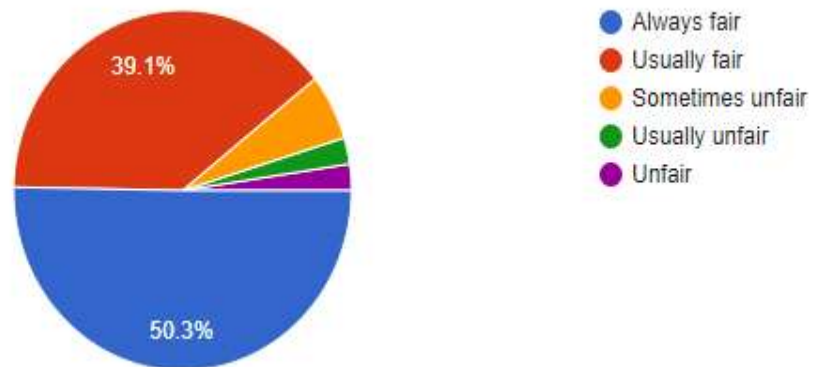

#### 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

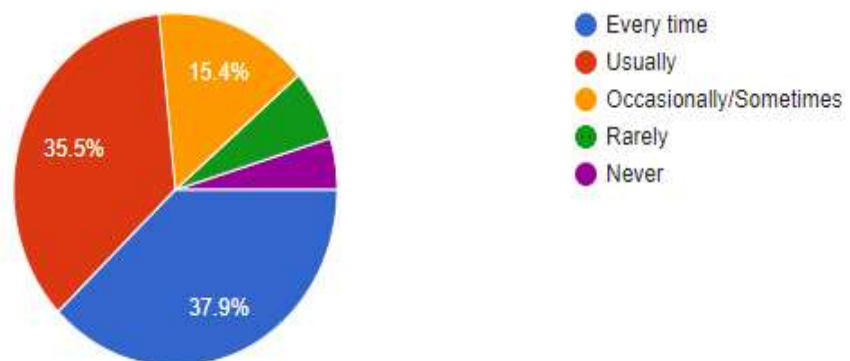

#### **6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?**

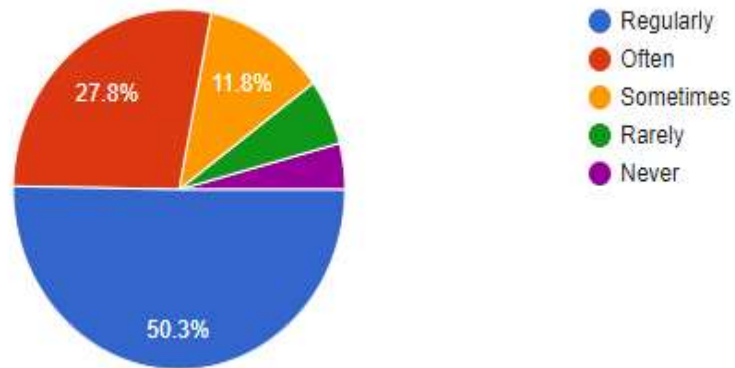

#### **7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.**

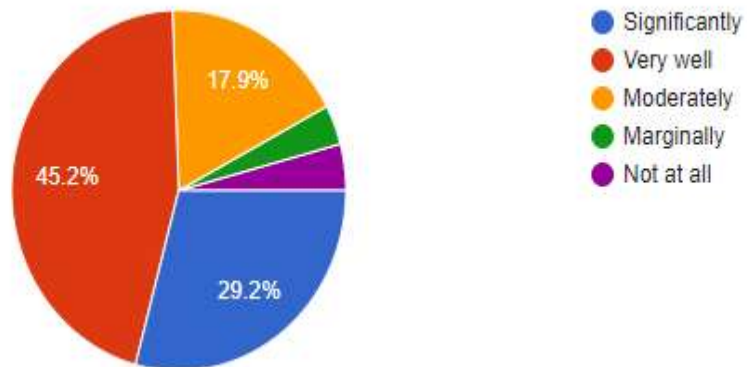

**8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.**

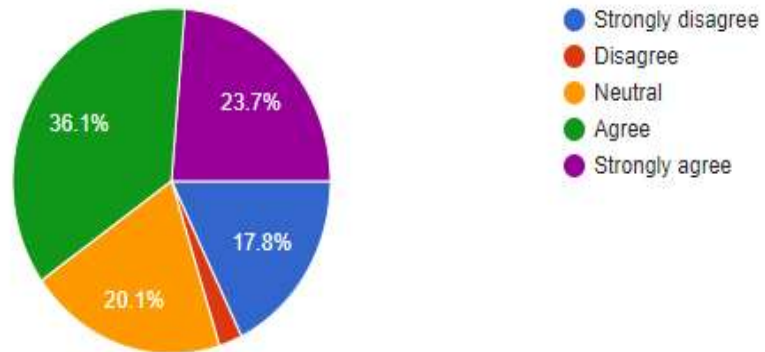

**9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.**

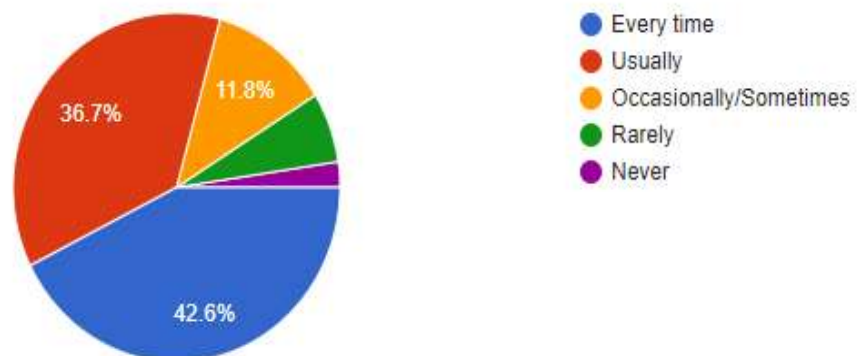

**10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.**

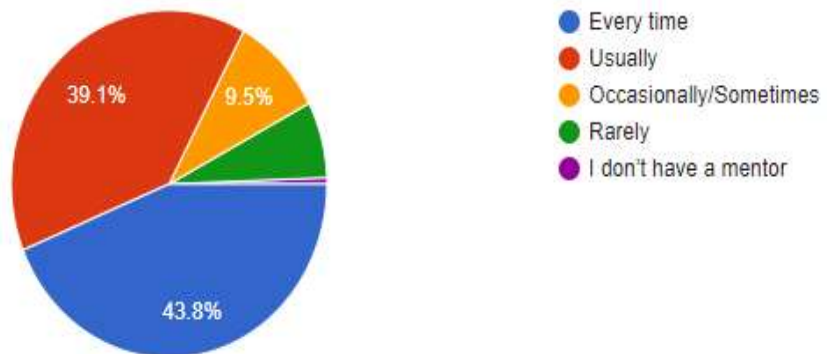

**11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.**

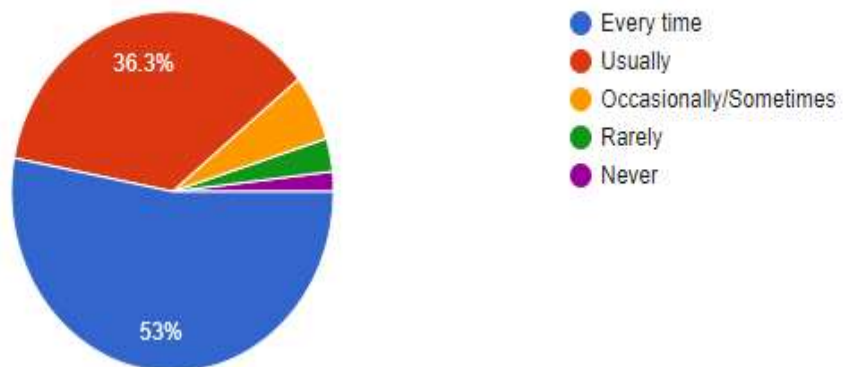

**12.The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.**

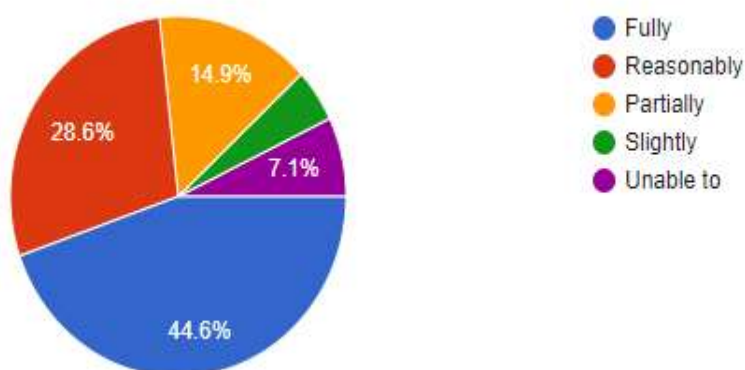
168 responses

**13.The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.**

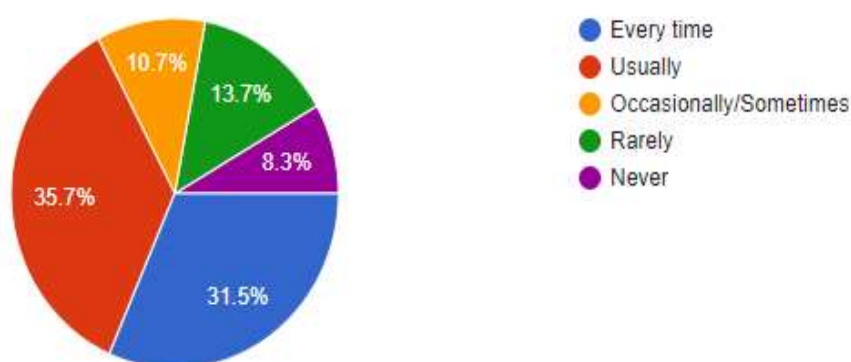

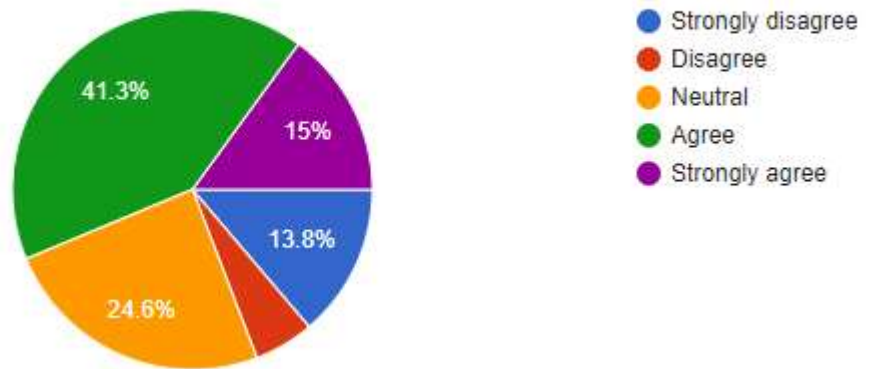


With a significant level of attention given to their students teachers assisted them in identifying and overcoming their areas of weakness by providing them with right direction and motivation.

**15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.**



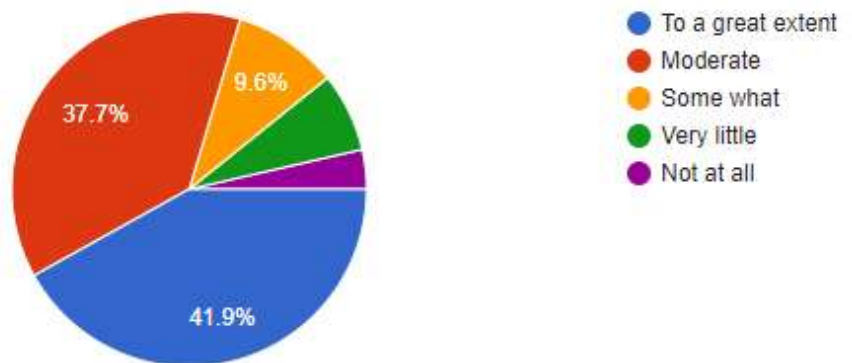

**16.The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.**

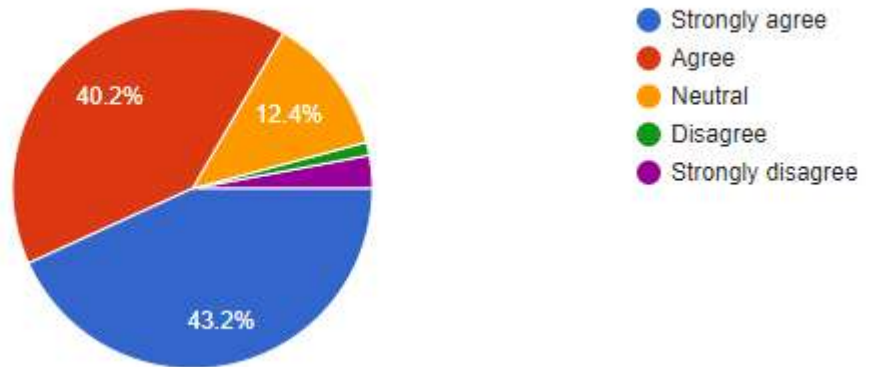

**17.Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.**

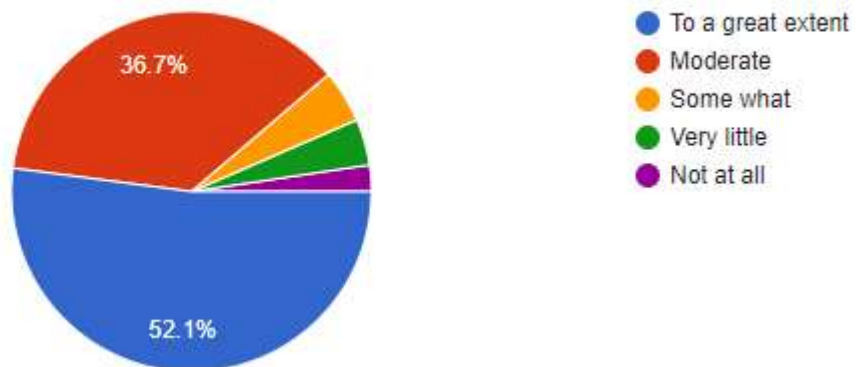

**18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.**

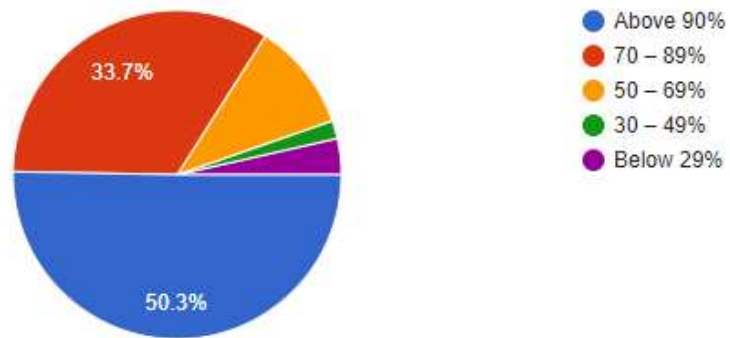

**19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.**

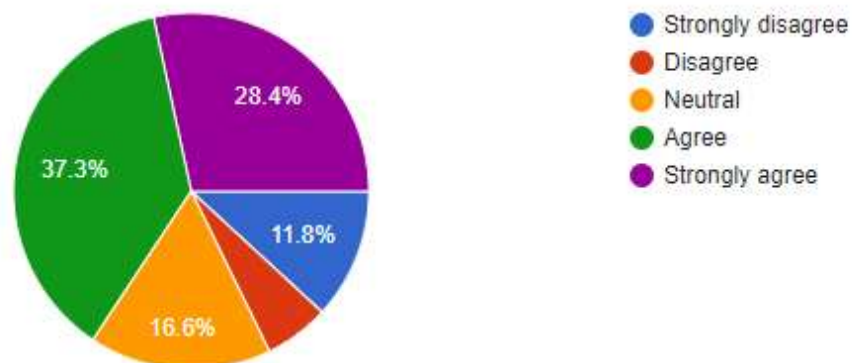
